VESSEL TRANSMITTING
The U.S. Coast Guard and the Pacific Ocean Search, Columbia Oil Spill, Law Enforcement, and other agencies use VESSEL TRANSMITTING (V-T) for vessel identification, location, and tracking. V-T is a one-way radio system that transmits a vessel's name, position, and other information. V-T is used by the Coast Guard, Alaska State Police, and other law enforcement agencies. V-T is also used by the fishing industry for vessel identification and tracking. V-T is a critical tool for vessel safety and security.

NOAA WEATHER STATION BROADCASTS
The NOAA Weather Station Broadcasts (WSB) provide real-time weather data for various locations. The WSB includes information on temperature, pressure, wind, and other weather variables. The WSB is used by mariners, pilots, and other users who need accurate weather information. The WSB is broadcast on a variety of radio frequencies, including VHF, HF, and satellite.

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
